Kent City Health Department COVID-19 Vaccination Update

Kent City Health Department is ready to provide certain COVID-19 vaccines to eligible customers. Those who are interested in receiving the vaccine may sign up through the City of Kent's website at <http://www.kentohio.org/701/Covid-19-Vaccine>. The health department currently has limited days and timeslots available and will be scheduling one month at a time. For those who are unable to schedule online, please call the health department at 330-678-8109.

Immunizations will be administered at 201 E East Erie St. on the ground floor of the PARTA Gateway. We ask that guests wear masks while in the building.

Individuals may choose between the Moderna (two-dose) vaccine or the Johnson & Johnson (one-dose) vaccine. Some vaccines will only be administered on certain days. We apologize for any inconvenience. Other vaccine providers can be found at gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov.
