

ORDINANCE NO. 2007- 111

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FUND 129, A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND WITHIN THE CITY BUDGET, TO BE ENTITLED "WIRELESS 911 FUND" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Auditor of State has informed the City that proceeds which are received from State agencies and which belong to the local government because of its participate in the enhanced wireless 911 emergency phone call processes must be accounted for in a separate, distinct fund, which the City will call the "Wireless 911 Fund".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Kent, Portage County, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Council does hereby authorize and create Fund 129, a Special Revenue Fund within the City budget, entitled "Wireless 911 Fund".

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
