A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM (NSP) GRANT FUNDING FOR THE COMMUNITIES OF THE CITY OF KENT, OHIO, THE CITY OF RAVENNA, OHIO, AND PORTAGE COUNTY, OHIO IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,253,137.00 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE AND SIGN A GRANT AGREEMENT/SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT FOR SAID NSP GRANT FUNDS, BETWEEN THE CITY OF KENT, OHIO, THE CITY OF RAVENNA, OHIO AND PORTAGE COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, NSP grants will be awarded shortly and the State of Ohio has given local communities only ten (10) days from the award of a NSP grant to return signed grant agreements/subrecipient agreements to the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the City Council will let the City Manager authorize and execute the required grant agreement/subrecipient agreement between their communities and the State of Ohio, and to accept said NSP grant funds on behalf of the City of Kent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager, or his designee, be and hereby is authorized in conjunction with the Community Development Director and the Law Director, to finalize and execute a grant agreement/subrecipient agreement between the City of Kent, Ohio, City of Ravenna, Ohio and Portage County, Ohio for the NSP grant funds on behalf of the City of Kent, Ohio.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept NSP grant funds on behalf of the City of Kent, Ohio.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
