

ORDINANCE NO. 2009- 31

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR A COOPERATIVE BOATING FACILITY GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF APPROXIMATELY \$ 250,000 THROUGH THE OHIO DEPT. OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent wishes to apply for a Cooperative Boating Facility Grant through the Ohio Dept. of Natural Resources in the amount of approximately \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the application must be filed by April 1, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Council does hereby authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to apply for a Cooperative Boating Facility Grant through the Ohio Dept. of Natural Resources in the amount of approximately \$250,000.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
