

**THE CITY OF KENT, OHIO
PUBLIC HEARING
WED., JULY 15, 2009**

This public hearing of the Kent City Council was called to order at 7:20 p.m. on Wed., July 15, 2009, by John Fender, Mayor & President of Council. Mayor Fender explained the purpose of this hearing was to obtain public comment on the proposed amendment to the Brimfield-Kent JEDD boundaries.

Jim Silver, Law Director, explained that anytime they expand JEDD boundaries, it must be done by a resolution passed by both Council and the Brimfield Township Trustees.

Mr. Silver said a public hearing is required by law, prior to amending the boundaries. He said by amending the boundaries, they will be adding three properties. He said two would be added by agreement, and one by prescription. He said this action will bring in three businesses.

Mayor Fender called for public comment at this time. Hearing none, he closed this public hearing at 7:21 p.m.
