

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-\_\_23\_\_

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM, (STP) FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO RESURFACE EAST SUMMIT STREET AND CRAIN AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent wishes to resurface East Summit Street, from just east of Loop Road to SR 261; said street having an existing Pavement Condition Index (PCI) of 41; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kent wishes to resurface Crain Avenue, from North Willow Street to Elmwood Drive; said street having an existing Pavement Condition Index (PCI) of 39; and

WHEREAS, total project costs are estimated at \$563,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager, or his designee is hereby authorized to apply for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following improvements:

- (a) East Summit Street Pavement Resurfacing: The existing Pavement Condition Index (PCI) of East Summit Street from just east of Loop Road to SR 261 is 41. The current opinion of probable project cost is \$361,000.
(b) Crain Avenue Pavement Resurfacing: The existing Pavement Condition Index for Crain Avenue from North Willow Street to Elmood Drive is 39. The current opinion of probable project cost is \$202,000.

SECTION 2. That the City of Kent acknowledges and understands the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
