

**THE CITY OF KENT, OHIO
PUBLIC HEARING
WED., APRIL 16, 2008**

This public hearing of Kent City Council was called to order by John Fender, Mayor and President of Council, who was absent, on April 16, 2008 at 7:20 p.m. Mayor Fender explained the purpose of this public hearing was to obtain comment on the proposed zoning text amendment for residential in industrial areas.
