



CALL FOR DESIGNS FOR THE NEW CITY OF KENT FLAG

The City of Kent is looking to replace its old flag design with a new design that better expresses the essence of Kent.

We are asking the public to participate and submit their design ideas to the office of the Clerk of Council. Please submit all required items no later than August 31, 2022 either in person or via mail (301 S. Depeyster St., Kent, OH 44240), or via email (in .PDF, .PNG, or .JPG format) to councilclerk@kent-ohio.org.

Flag Design Parameters

1. The designer must have been born in, work in, or live in the City of Kent
2. The design must be simple enough to be easily replicable from memory
3. Symbolism must be meaningful
4. 2-3 basic colors (4-5 if justified)
5. No lettering, writing, or seals
6. Be distinctive, no replication or “plagiarism” of other existing flags
7. A written explanation for each element, color, etc. included must accompany the submission, along with your name, phone number, and address.

Other Notes

1. A number of designs will be chosen from those submitted and designers may be invited to collaborate on a final design.
