

ORDINANCE NO. 2007- 21

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500.00 TO THE CITY OF KENT POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, LODGE #70 FOR THE PURCHASE AND TRAINING OF A POLICE K-9 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent Police Department has received a donation of \$500.00 from the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #70 for the purchase and training of a Police K-9.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio, at least seven (7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Council does hereby authorize the City Manager on behalf of the City of Kent to accept the donation of \$500.00 from the Fraternal Order of Police to be used for the purchase and training of a Police K-9.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
